SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Lev. 13:1-2, 44-46 - Psalm 32:1-2, 5,11 - Cor. 10:31-11:1 Gospel - Mark 1:40-45

To the Jewish people, the word Leprosy in Hebrew could mean a number of skin conditions, some of which could be cured, or would disappear in time, so they made provision for those temporary cases. The complex and rather confusing regulations set out in Leviticus provided that the sufferer could be re-admitted to their society, once the absence of symptoms was verified by priests.

By contrast we see in the Responsorial Psalm today that one does not need to be "cleaned up" to come to our merciful God. He is only too happy to render us "clean" and remove all stain of sin when we come to Him and ask, with repentant and contrite hearts. Our God is a merciful God who does not cast out those marked with the stain of sin (Leprosy of the soul), but instead He welcomes all who will come to Him and accept His forgiveness in humble surrender to Him. "Then I acknowledged my sin to you, my guilt I covered not. I said, "I confess my faults to the Lord", and you took away my sin." This is Mercy from the Heart of the Father.

In the Gospel today, we don't know how the leper heard about Jesus, but he certainly was gifted with great faith in Jesus' healing power. He even broke the law that governed him at the time. by touching Jesus. He probably hadn't experienced human touch for quite some time, because of his condition. Lepers were regarded as untouchable. Jesus touched him and made him clean. Jesus commanded, "Be made clean" and so he was. The disease left him by the authority of Jesus' Word. When we go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and kneel before the Priest, we are like the leper — we come in faith for healing/forgiveness; for healing of our souls from the burden and stain of sin that we carry. The Priest stretches forth his hand, and by the anointed word spoken by the priest, the Lord takes away the guilt of our sin as far as the east is from the west. As the lepers were told to make a sacrifice of thanksgiving when they receive healing, we too should offer thanksgiving to Jesus for freeing us from our leprosy of sin, and restoring us back to spiritual health.

Like the leper we should testify to our healing of sin by living changed lives, and by doing even the smallest things for the Glory of God, as Paul says in the second reading today.

As Lent is fast approaching, perhaps we can reflect on the "lepers" of today, and look at how we think about them. The "lepers" of today can be all those whom society does not want to recognize, or acknowledge because they "don't fit" the acceptable societal norms. They may be street people, the mentally fragile, addicts, or even a neighbour you don't get along with, etc. Perhaps if we remember that we too are "lepers" in terms of sin, that Jesus does not judge us or cast us away because we are unclean (or difficult to deal with), but has compassion on us, and is willing to give us another chance again, and again, and again Even in the smallest of things, let us make a commitment this Lent to do all things for the Glory of God, and to love into wholeness those whom we would look upon as "untouchable".

If we are to be imitators of Christ, as Paul was, then we must be willing to reach out and touch all humanity with love, compassion and mercy, for the benefit of many, that they may be saved. Amen!
