March 3rd 2018 – THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Oh How Disfigured are we?

Just imagine how much time we have been sitting in front of the mirror when getting ready to go somewhere? We want to make sure that we look pleasant, our dress is neat etc. This is what we show to the outer world. How can we see inside of us? That is what God gave to us on Mount Sinai, which we read in our first reading today.

We can see the Ten Commandments in many ways. One way is his loving voice. The danger is when we hear another voice too. "Oh this is just a warning only. You are free to break it". When we break the commandments the very same voice asks us to break the commandments also says "Now you are guilty", "God doesn't love you now". etc. That is why people say "When we break commandments, commandments will break us". Isn't this what we are observing in today's world?

We can see the Ten Commandments as a mirror of our spirit. We are created in his image and he wants us to keep his image unchanged. It is his will. When we are guilty of breaking them, we will see a distorted figure when we see through that mirror. It is feedback from him for our actions. When we have feedback, all we have to do is some repair work for our actions. This cannot be done only by us. He has created the sacrament of reconciliation for that purpose too. He is the creator. He knows what parts to service. All we have to do is go to him with complete faith and say "I am Sorry" with true repentance. When we come back after the absolution we can see a nice picture of ourselves. Have we ever looked at that?

In today's gospel Jesus enters in the temple just before the Passover. Please don't look at the church building for a moment. Let that building be there. Our heart is God's temple too. If Jesus enters our hearts today, what would he find? Pleasant, calm place to stay. Aren't we exchanging thoughts of anger, hatred, injustice, impurity, etc. instead of love, mercy, peace, justice? (Now we are free to reflect on how many commandments we have broken?) Will one whip be enough for us? Do you think he will use the whip on us? I don't think so. He will use the whip on our actions. Not on us. Because he loves us immensely. He wants his image to be reconstructed but he never imposes bur proposes. Truth is even with these failures, he wants us to come back to him and he is ready to forgive our sins. All he wants is to give the truth of our hearts.

Please let Jesus enter our hearts during this season. Let him destroy all evil actions in our hearts. It might hurt us because our routines might change. That is OK. Then he will make our hearts better places for him.
