March 11th 2018 – FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Are we Agents of God?

Throughout the readings we are reminded about the agents of God. In first reading Cyrus, the king of Persia as an agent of God. Because of the sins of the Jewish people, from the priests down, because of idolatry and other shameful and sacrilegious practices and after God sent them messenger after messenger who were not listened to, a terrible punishment fell on the whole people. Then Cyrus, the king of Persia, became the agent of God by which God's people were once more able to return to Jerusalem and begin to rebuild their traditions and a new Temple.

In Gospel Jesus revels he is the agent for God's salvation.

For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.

We all know God's love is unconditional and he wants for us to extend the same love for others. But do we have that grace? Most of us don't. Why? There is a secret.

Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near (Philippians 4:5) What is this gentleness? To really understand this we have to read Luke 6:35-36. (I will not place it here because of the space constraints). It requests us to love all WITHOUT EXPECTING ANYTHING. Most of the time we serve people (in our family, church, society etc.), we love people but in deep down our heart we expect at least a word of appreciation, nice face, good smile, hug etc. (simply a response of appreciation). When we don't receive it we will become bitter and sometime angry or non-responsive in our heart. This happens while we volunteer as well as in families too. It is the truth. Sometimes we work for what we get paid only. This is what my employer is giving me I will work only this much. Are we gentle?

Some might ask what is wrong with that. By living such a life we are living a life with total contradictions with the principles and values of God. Let is discuss how. As Catholics we are dependent on God. If not, we should? Our happiness, Joy, Hope comes only from God. Right? If we are on that base how can we have a Pinocchio nose and long face when a person is not giving us response of appreciation? Can we? If we are having Pinocchio nose and long face it means we are not grounded to our base. We are not doing it for that person. Do we? Same way if we are underpaid don't we have a guarantee that Lord we take care of my finances? (I do have personal experience on this)

Most probably we can understand how we can be blessed by Jesus now. We have to take away all our gloomy exterior and start blessing people around us, no matter what circumstance we are in. This small story will help us to understand it. (I don't know if it is true or not but we can see the point),

A certain saint asked God to show her the difference between heaven and hell. So God sent an angel to take her, first to hell. There she saw men and women seated around a large table with all kinds of delicious food. But none of them were eating. They were all sad and yawning. The saint asked one of them, "Why are you not eating?" And he showed her his hand. A long fork about 4ft long was strapped to their hands such that each time they tried to eat they only threw the food on the ground. "What a pity" said the saint. Then the angel took her to heaven. There the saint was surprised to find an almost identical setting as in hell: men and women sitting round a large table with all sorts of delicious food, and with a fourfoot fork strapped to their arms. But unlike in hell, the people here were happy and laughing. "What!" said the saint to one of them, "How come you are happy in this condition?" "You see," said the man in heaven, "Here we feed one another."


