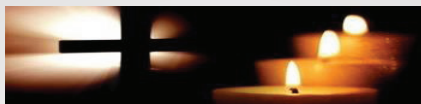

March 18th 2018 – FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Ready for a Change?

God, who is Love, wants to love us in a permanent, faithful relationship, which is similar to marriage, only better. As married couples make a covenant with each other by exchanging marriage vows, so the Lord made covenants with Noah, Abraham, Moses, David, and all His chosen people. The problem with these covenants was that God's people broke them all. Human beings seem incapable of keeping a covenant with God, incapable of loving God faithfully.

Therefore, God promised to make a new covenant. He said: "I will place my law within them, and write it upon their hearts; I will be their God, and they shall be my people".

What is this law? It is the law of forgiveness and mercy and nothing else.

In the Gospel Jesus says to his disciples "Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat". Today he is saying that to us. We are His garden and He wants us to be fruitful. Thus we have to die to our own desires and let forgiveness and mercy be seen by others.

(Remember last week we discussed about this too)

Simply each day, we must move away from our sins and desires. When we attempt to die to the promptings of the flesh and choose to obey God, we begin a new life of producing real fruit, a harvest of grace and goodness. In doing this, we should glorify God, since we are doing this only by his Grace.

This is a journey. To begin this journey we have to practice obedience and submission which is not easy. We can receive our new nature and covenant by remembering our baptismal promises. We are not too far from now, for a renewal of our baptismal promises anyway. Better get prepared and do it meaningfully. Most of us need resurrection without crucifixion; the glory without the cross. As Jesus says in today's gospel it doesn't work that way. We have to go through Good Friday to have Easter Sunday.

Get ready for a change. Get ready to die to our desires. Then we will see laws were inside us, but we were afraid only for resistance.
