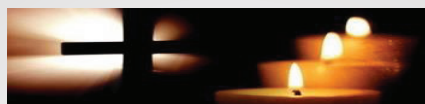

March 25th 2018 – PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION

Reflection for Palm Sunday – Such obedience and humility?

After driving out demons, healing the sick, and raising the dead, it was time for the King of Kings to enter the Holy City. But to do so, he rode not on the back of a warhorse, but a donkey. His companions accompanied him brandishing not swords, but palm branches. The monument to his victory, erected a week later, was not an arch, but a crucifix.

Jesus did this under his humility and obedience to the father. He humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted him.

His whole life was humiliating. No room in the inn. Born in a stable. Hunted by Herod's henchmen. Growing up in a far-flung province of the Roman Empire—Galilee, the land where the country accent is so thick, you can cut it with a knife. How is it that the high priest's servant-girl knew Peter was a disciple of Jesus? His hillbilly accent gave him away (Matthew 26:73). Jesus disciples were not certified or educated. They were drawn from the low-life of a backwater region.

On top of this God did not want Jesus to die. God didn't impose it on him. He did not want Jesus' blood or sacrifice. He did not want Jesus to suffer either. God wanted only obedience – at least from one man, throughout his whole life to erase the sin caused by the disobedience. That was the proposal.

As an answer Jesus freely plunged to the depths of human misery, joining himself to our frail nature, entering into our turbulent world. As if this act of humility were not enough, he further humbled himself, accepting the status of a slave. Knowing that Judas is going to betray him, Jesus washed his feet and shared his meal with him. Knowing that the agony he is going to suffer is too big, He bowed his head to the will of the Father. He did not say a word to defend himself nor did he do anything to prove His innocence or divinity during the trial. He did not resent or object to any kind of torture He had to face. He did not hate anyone who tortured Him, but loved everyone till the end – till He said "Father it is finished". He did all this in obedience to His Father's will. When Jesus said "It is finished" God exalted Him. He made the name Jesus venerable to a point that whoever confesses His name with reverence would be saved. The Father could do this only because Jesus submitted himself to His Will in obedience.

It is this obedience we need to please God and share the glory of Jesus and be the source of his glory to others. So, let us pray today to Jesus to help us to obey God under any and all circumstances.

Today is Palm Sunday. We all enter the church with a palm leaf in our hand waving it, saying Hosanna. In the first instance, the people who waived palms shouted "crucify him" a week later. May be to resemble them, most of us turn the palms we waived into crosses before the end of the mass. If you have made a cross out of your palm, fix it somewhere you may see it every morning and whenever you see it promise Jesus that it will be the last cross you make for him out of disobedience. Otherwise when you see the palm leaf, promise Jesus that you will never make any crosses for him, and ask His help to be obedient to the Father – not to sin.



My dear parishioners,

I am writing this note with a heavy heart since I just came from the funeral service of a 23 weeks old stillborn baby. I had no words to console the young parents whose marriage I blessed, whom I greeted on Sundays after Mass. The grieving mother Kathy (name changed to protect privacy) asked me: what did I do wrong, Fr. James?

As we go through this Holy Week, Kathy's question sounds familiar; isn't it? Mary could have asked that question. Jesus Himself could have asked that question. You and I might have asked that question many or few times when life became tough or meaningless. When we deal with sorrow beyond our control we tend to doubt our faith and our God. The Holy Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter) celebration will give answers and strength to our wavering hearts. This great celebration helps us to re-focus our faith and convictions and enable us to surrender to the will of God. We see the Son of God surrendering to the will of His Father which made him the King and Savior of the world. Surrendering to the will of God made Mary the Mother of God as well. May these Pascal mysteries help us follow Jesus and His blessed mother.
