MAY 13th, 2018 - THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD



"Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go." Alleluia!

He is risen! He is Ascended to the right hand of the Father!

In today's readings, Paul reiterates how he has professed

all that Jesus did and taught, until the day He ascended to Heaven, after having given instructions to the Apostles whoSm He had chosen. After His resurrection Jesus continued to appear to them over a period of 40 days, giving them assurance that it was indeed Him.

Also, He continued to teach them about the Kingdom of God, to strengthen them and prepare them for what was to come, and Who (Holy Spirit) was to come to them. Paul says that Jesus "ordered" them not to leave Jerusalem, but to stay there and wait for the promise of the Father. How well do we wait, in obedience, for the Lord's promises to manifest in our lives? Jesus reminded them that they had heard that promise from Him previously, that they would be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now. Once the Holy Spirit was to come upon them, Jesus told them that they would be witnesses to the Gospel, even to the ends of the earth. We too are His witnesses when we share the Gospel at every opportunity, "even to the ends of the earth". When we permit the Holy Spirit to enter our hearts, set them on fire with the Love of God and our neighbour, He will surely open our voices to speak the Truth of Salvation to all who will listen. We pray for revelation and wisdom as we are enlightened to the glorious Hope that we have in Him.

As Jesus ascended before their eyes, two angels came to them and reassured them that Jesus would return, just as they were seeing Him leave, on the clouds of Heaven. They were given comfort and hope that they would see Him again. As He promised, they would not be left as orphans, He (Jesus) will be with them (us) even to the end of the age. He is the Head and we, His people, are the Body, the fullness of the Church, and the fullness of Him who fills all, in all. He has filled all things from His descent to His ascent. "It is finished". Complete and whole. Now, seated at the right hand of the Father, all things have been placed under His feet. He is The Sovereign Lord of ALL.

We have been called to the blessed Hope, who is Jesus. We have been called! He has sovereignty over all. He is above every name that is named with full power, authority and dominion. We belong to Him, brothers and sisters, and therefore can have the fullness of Joy and nothing to fear. May our active Faith in Jesus be the witness to others of the Gospel (Good News), as we live our lives following His commands to Love, and at every opportunity to speak about why we believe. We all have a testimony to share. You may be the only Gospel some people will ever hear and see. Let them see, that they may believe. You have been called in your state of life to share the Gospel at all opportunities that are presented. Will you? Only Faith in Jesus the Christ saves. How can they believe, if they have not heard? There is one Body and one Spirit. Gifts were given by Jesus that some would be Apostles, some Prophets, some Evangelists, some Pastors and some Teachers. This, so that the Body would be built up and equipped for every person to be brought into unity in Christ in the faith, and knowledge of Jesus, the Son of the One True Living God. One – that is why He died – that we all would be One in Him as He is in the Father – One. He is the Way the Truth and the Life, and in His own words He states that "no one comes to the Father, except by me". Thus, the Gospel must be preached in every home, highway, byway, school, business, on the face of the entire earth, that ALL may have the opportunity to hear, and come to know, that Jesus is Lord to the Glory of God the Father, and attain the salvation that He died to give to ALL. Amen!
