MAY 27th, 2018 – THE MOST HOLY TRINITY



The Holy Trinity was firmly established in the Bible, even in Genesis. Throughout the Old Testament God refers to Himself in both the singular and plural. In fact, in Genesis He declares

"Let us make man in our image." Note both the "us" and the "our."

The doctrine of the Trinity can be a difficult concept to grasp: One God, yet three distinct persons. It is a mystery that requires faith. However, I have been privileged to hear an analogy that was inspiring, and I would like to share it with you here: Take the egg. It contains three independent parts, each having its own function, yet it is one unit: the shell, the white and the yolk. Each of these parts has significant individual properties, all coming together as one. The Holy Trinity likewise is One, with three independently functioning parts – Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Godhead, three persons in one. If you have had difficulty in grasping this doctrine by faith, I hope this analogy has succeeded in opening this truth to your heart in order to have a better understanding.

This Trinity Sunday, the Gospel from Matthew, even though not lengthy, contains Jesus' commission to us to go and "make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the **name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.**" Disciples are made through teaching and through conversion. Our conversion is ongoing from glory to glory as we submit to God, as only God can accomplish the conversion of our hearts and minds. By the power of the Holy Spirit, we do and say what we see and hear Jesus doing and saying, just as He did what He saw the Father do and said what He heard the Father say: Trinity. One. Unity. Obedience. We do this by prayer, reading the Word of God, and by meditating on the Word of God allowing it to penetrate our hearts and minds with truth which is sharper than any two-edged sword.

We are called to mission. Each one in our own station in life, and some (like the Apostles) to go out beyond that space to evangelize and spread the Good News of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all who will listen and, yes, even to those who won't, teaching them to obey everything that Jesus has commanded. To give us comfort, Jesus tells us that He is with us always, even to the end of the age. He sent His Holy Spirit as our comforter and consoler. He comforts us so that we will not fear – as Paul says in the second reading today, "For you did not receive a Spirit of Slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received a spirit of adoption to sonship." Men, Women and Children of St. Anne's parish, we are children of God. When we cry "Abba, Father", it is the Spirit bearing witness to this fact. The Spirit reminds us of everything that Jesus told us, as the Father told Him. As we live in the Fruit of the Spirit, we evidence the presence of the Holy Spirit in us to the world.

In the First Reading from Deuteronomy it also states, "Keep His statutes and His commandments, which I am commanding you today, for your own wellbeing and that of your descendents after you, so that you may long remain in the land that the Lord your God is giving you for **all time**". From the Old Testament to the New Testament we are commanded to obey the commands of God , and teach others to do the same – for our own benefit, and to glorify God in the earth. Moses was talking to the Israelites at that time, but we see that as they strayed from this Truth, they did get dispersed from their land, twice. Only in these days are they finally returning to the land that God has given them for **all time** – many Jews now believe, by divine revelation, that Jesus iss the Messiah that they have been waiting for, and that He is coming again on the clouds of Heaven as promised in Acts 11.

Alleluia, Alleluia. Glory to the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit: to God who is, who was and who is to come. Alleluia.
