PARABLE OF THE MUSTARD SEED

Today's gospel we have "Parable of the Growing Seed" and "Parable of the Mustard Seed". In both parables God is the farmer. As we can see the man who sowed the seed goes about his business day by day not realizing what is happening to the seed. But it ends with harvest. There are situations that we have neglected or denied some statements in our past and all of a sudden the very same things we denied (or had a difficulty to accept) become real without any difficultly (especially about faith). This is what we call "seed growing secretly". Nobody knows how it happens, but it happens. Simply only God knows. There may be situations we had lot of arguments about the faith and almost left the church. But somehow (now we realize it is the Grace of God) we remain. After some time almost all of our questions were answered and feel like dumb people. This was because we were trying to get artificial harvest by using our intelligence. It was not the intention of God. He wants us to be humble so he will protect us, guide us and make us useful in his work. That is why St Paul says "I planted, Apollos watered, but God caused the growth".

This will help us see things differently. Did we see change in us when we were in doubts? Certainly Not. But there was a growth. Wasn't it? Harvest came because someone planted the seed. All we have to do is plant the seed. God will look after the rest. We cannot be discouraged. Kingdom of God is growing secretly but steadily.

The "Parable of the Mustard Seed" shares the same kind of message from a different angle. I have read somewhere that two hundred forty thousand Mustard Seeds make a pound. Yes, the Church starts very small. Today it gives shelter to many. Who receives the shelter from this huge tree? Then who has the responsibility to protect this tree from persecution and other circumstances? There may be different kinds of birds wanting to come and visit since the tree gives us free shelter. Maybe some want to take branches away. This will leave some open ended questions to us as well.

If we really want to work on these parables we can do one thing. Read at least one passage from the bible. Let God work that scripture passage in your heart. One day it will happen.
