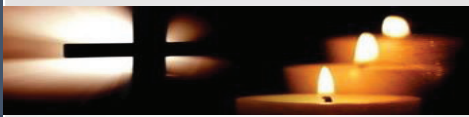

Heart of the Law or Law of the Heart?

Today’s first reading starts with Moses introducing the law to the people before they occupy the land God gave them. He says “This great nation is truly a wise and intelligent people. For what great nation is there that has gods so close to it as the LORD, our God, is to us whenever we call upon him? “. Looks like a pretty close nation to God who has very close connection with him. Isn’t it? But was that the case? As we already know, by the time of Jesus’ people had made law hopelessly complicated people were moving away from God. This was mainly because the law was not helping people build up a relationship with God and others. Law was used only to check out one’s own external behavior. Today’s gospel has a good example, washing of hands. Yes, it is good to have as a hygienic rule but should it go to the level it has gone?

Sometimes we are like that too. We judge others by their actions but we judge ourselves by our intentions. Don’t we? Why is this? This is because we don’t have a relationship with God. Good example is our confession. Many of the "sins" we confess are often phrased as personal failures (I lost my temper, I was impatient, I was lazy, I was uncharitable) with very little references. But where are the times I lost my connection with God by ignoring oneself in the street, not reaching out to somebody I should have reached out in my work place, any other sins of omissions.

Being a Catholic is holding a huge responsibility. We have to ask ourselves who Jesus is. For some he is Healer, for some he is a Miracle Worker, for some he is an Activist, for some he is looking after Human Rights, for some he is Socialist, and the list can go on, but as Simon Peter said He is God. He cannot be limited to one category. If we are limiting him to one category then we are not seeing his full capacity. God wants his followers to work with him regularly (not part time but full time). He wants us to mingle with people; i.e. anybody we can meet starting with our family (there is no bypass switch for family). He wants us to care and share our joy and their sorrow with them. He wants his light to reflect from us (not our light to shine). If we haven’t done that, we have not met his expectation. It is one reason for confession. We are suppose to try again and again. We then have to move out. In church or community we meet people. The least we can do is treat them with a smile. A true Catholic can reach out to anybody in need - Those that don’t have anything to eat, nothing to drink, people in senior homes, single mothers, drug addicts, etc. - Jesus doesn’t want us to stop there. He wants us to clear the obstacles they are facing. (Reasons for these situations). At least to voice for a change. It is the duty of following Jesus.

Simply religion (Catholicism) has little to do with the observance of laws but more of doing the following:

- Being liberated from the corrupting influences of our environment, and
- Being sensitive to the needs of the weakest and most marginalized among us.

This is true Catholicism because "as often as you did/did not do it to one of the least of my brothers and sisters you did/did not do it to ME". This will be the question we will be answerable to at the end of our lives. Unfortunately, we confess about what we fell short of “observing the law” and neglect being sensitive part and liberate part.

In the final analysis, each one has to discern for themselves (under the given circumstances) just how he / she can best love and serve Christ. It calls for a great deal of honesty, integrity and a high level of real freedom, the freedom to choose what is good, what is better, what is more loving. The Gospel is not a code of laws. It provides a vision of a truly human life lived for God among other people. It is focused on relationships rather than individual actions.

This and any day we will have many opportunities to love and serve Jesus in various situations. Instead of being anxious of what I may do wrong ("Is it a sin?"), we can ask, "Where and how can I be a more loving, caring and compassionate person this day?"

Can we move to the law of the heart or still be stuck with heart of the law?
