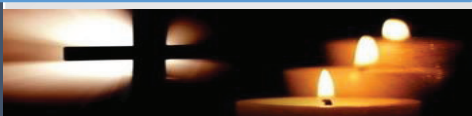

## SEPTEMBER 16, 2018 – TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY N ORDINARY TIME

### **Jesus Who Are You?**

Last Sunday we saw the story of the healing of a man who was deaf and dumb. Today we see Jesus is asking a good question from his disciples and revealing important things about himself and his work. Most interestingly these revelations will be folded by stages in the very same way the blind man (in Bethsaida) receives healing.

Jesus who are you? - Let's imagine Jesus asks the question "Who do people say that I am?" today from us. As we pointed out two weeks ago for some he is Healer, for some he is a Miracle Worker, for some he is an Activist, for some he is looking after Human Rights, for some he is Socialist and the list can go on. Peter had the real answer. "You are the Christ". Most of the time we limit Jesus to a category of our needs and forget about all his other attributes. When we lose a job we ask him "can you please get me a job?" and only see him as a miracle worker. We do not see him or big picture that we can enjoy sometime with our family and especially with Jesus. In the same way when we are in a problem we see Jesus as a problem solver. We forget he is the creator of this universe and we are his creations. Most of the times we try to teach the creator how to amend our lives but he has a broad vision for us.

God wants his followers to work with him regularly (not part time but full time). He wants us to mingle with people; i.e. anybody we can meet starting with our family (there is no bypass switch for family). He wants us to care and share our joy and their sorrow with them. He wants his light to reflect from us (not our light to shine). True Catholics can reach out to anybody in need - those that don't have anything to eat, nothing to drink, people in senior homes, single mothers, drug addicts etc. - Jesus doesn't want us to stop there. He wants us to clear the obstacles they are facing. (Reasons for these situations). At least to voice for a change. Here is the most important thing. We have to gain strength for all these through Jesus. How? Holy Mass is the best way to get the continuous strength and maintain relationship with Jesus. That is why Jesus cannot be a mere Socialist or Activist without spiritual component. When we get that understanding the whole picture is different it will come down to "Law of the Heart" (not the Heart of the Law). Those who experience Jesus really will definitely say "He is a force that will change our hearts". When that force (it is a living force) touches you there is no turning back. Today's first reading confirms this.

The Lord GOD opens my ear that I may hear; and I have not rebelled, have not turned back.

### **Who are those with real faith?**

James today in the Second Reading speaks about those people who have "faith", that is, they claim to be believers in Christ and the Gospel but nothing of that appears in their lives. They pray piously, are seen at Mass every Sunday, they are experts in doctrine and orthodox teaching, but they do very little to help others.

Those who have real faith are those who have faith and work both. It is time to come out from our comfort zone and show our real faith to Jesus (not to others). If we open our hearts for this call then He will open the gates of heaven when we say: "Ephphatha!" because we have fulfilled at least a small task for our neighbour.
