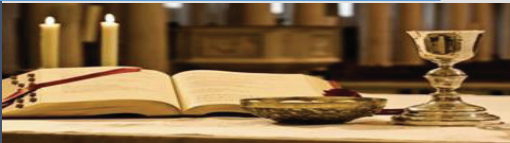

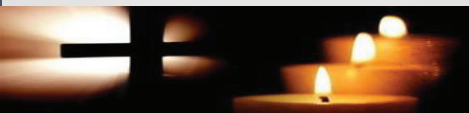

### Ready for Amputation?

We see some important issues are raised in today's gospel and first reading. In the Gospel we see that the disciples are not at all happy because they saw a complete stranger, one who has nothing to do with their Master — who was not a disciple — cast out evil spirits. Probably they are jealous / angry and thought "Who is this person doing our job?" They try to stop him. Case has gone to Jesus. His response was:

*Do not prevent him. For whoever is not against us is for us. Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward.*

Don't we act like apostles sometimes? Within the Church, too, there have always been groups — and they are still among us — that feel they have something that no one else has. It is the truth. Some groups are willing to take certain amount of time and energy to prove that other groups or even the rest of the Church is deeply in error. Knowingly or unknowingly what they do is trying to keep people away from God and claim that salvation belongs only to them. Pardon the language but they are acting like dogs who are barking at the people who willingly come to Jesus. They think they are protecting the church but they are really harming the church because they have no real love. There may be individuals too.

Truth is God does his work through all kinds of people and that many of them are very good. Perhaps those people believe in another religion or belong to no recognized religious grouping. Yet, they believe — in a way that can shame us Catholics — in the importance of truth, justice, love, service freedom, peace and non-violence.

Jesus is dead set against jealous people being sad at others' successes and thereby saddening the Holy Spirit (Eph. 4:30). He warns that if we're jealous of other people's hands because they work better than ours, then we should cut off our own hands rather than remain rooted in jealousy. If we're jealous of others' speed, strength, or health, we should cut off our feet. If we're jealous of how others look, we should tear out one of our eyes. If you have a "jealous bone in your body," Jesus says to take out the bone or amputate that part of your body.

St John, in his First Letter, says very bluntly: "Wherever there is a caring love (agape) there is God." Christians clearly have no monopoly on loving others. And we can add that wherever there is true justice / freedom/peace / non-violence being practised, there is God; On the other hand, as a Christian, through my baptism, I have been called, it is my vocation, to be there for others as another Christ. It contradicts with being jealous. We need to hear the words of Moses today: "Would that all the people of the LORD were prophets! Would that the LORD might bestow his spirit on them all!"

I am called not only to be for myself a good person. I am called to reach out, to love, to be just to others, to be fully free with and for others, to be truly brother or sister. I am also called to be a prophet, to proclaim in words and actions that the Source of all love, justice, freedom and solidarity with others is a God who loves, who forgives and who wants all to share in a life that is enriched on every level.

Be an image of God not Dog.

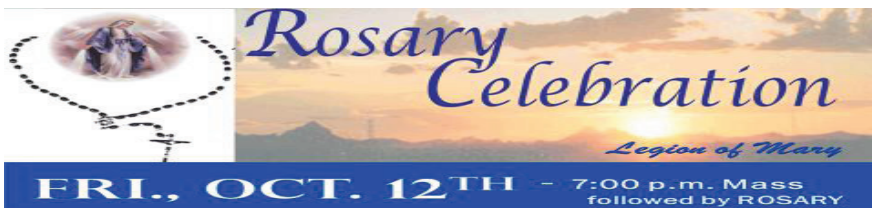
