OCTOBER 7th, 2018 – TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The primary purpose of religion is to help us move beyond the separate-self sense to union with God. — Thomas Keating

In today's gospel it is very evident that some of the Pharisees questioning Jesus were very much in a separate – self state.

What does this mean exactly? It means that they thought and acted from the view point of the self, without any empathy towards the well being of others above their own. Jesus' response make this point very clear.

'Because of your hardness of heart he (Moses) wrote this commandment for you.'

As far as they were concerned, as long as they observed the letter of the law they were within their rights, and all was good between them and God. But, Jesus teaches us that, the law does not generate love and goodwill towards one another, much less extend goodwill to mankind as a whole. The law exacts from each one of us, (if we adhere to it), the minimum that's expected from us. It will keep us out of jail. It will not, however, change the world, it will not nurture the weak, feed the hungry, clothe the naked, it will not set the captives free. That is why, Jesus teaches us to go beyond the Law, to go to the spirit of the law. The Beatitudes are Jesus' standard. It is the only way we can bring about the Kingdom of God rather than the rule of Man.

Going to Sunday Mass without taking time to study and learn the Word of God and without applying in our daily lives what we profess to believe, does not generate a burning desire in our hearts to know and love Jesus, with all our being, through loving others as ourselves.

The Pharisees missed the purpose of their religion and many of us do the same today also. Marriage is a sacrament where we have no choice, if we are to persevere in the marriage and raise children, but to move beyond the separate-self. It is in this arena that we are challenged to abandon the self for the well being of the other. The family. This is only the starting point, this is where the training takes place. Our relationship with our spouse, children, siblings and all family members and in-laws are only an indicator of how far we've grown in love and understanding of the love of God. After all family is a safe place to learn, they will always welcome us back and love us no matter how selfish we may behave. We all agree selfishness must be overcome, because if we do not die to self we cannot be part of Christ. Jesus The Christ, The Lord of Heaven and earth kept nothing for Himself when He walked the earth. He gave His heavenly post to take on our humanity, knowing He would suffer under human hands the most extreme cruelties that any human being can possibly perpetrate. Through Him, it is possible for all cruelty and death to end and a new life may begin.

Jesus came so we can walk in His The Way, know the Truth and have life In Him

Jesus Christ and Him crucified is the religion we follow. It leads us to the resurrection, a life beyond the separate-self and in the ultimate union with Christ in unity with the Holy Spirit and in union with all of creation.

How do we do this? " If we love one another, God will live in us in perfect love." 1 John 4.12

NOTE that there is no request for funds in these initial communications – this is often a strategy used by criminals phishing for victims. To this point, the people being targeted are members of religious orders.


