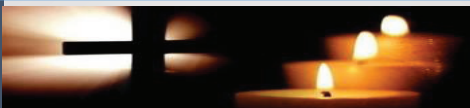

Gospel of Mark 10. 17 -30

“A man ran up and knelt before him (Jesus) and asked him, “Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?”

²¹And Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, “You lack one thing: go, sell all that you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me.” ²²Disheartened by the saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.”

Jesus message is always consistent, to be truly with Him, walk with Him we must do more than adhere to the 10 commandments. That is just the foundation, being part of the ushering the kingdom of God requires us to put on the Mind of Christ as St. Paul says. Christians are not responsible simply for their salvation, they are commissioned to declare the Good News so others may enter the Kingdom also.

Are we using our utmost potential to work as one people for the ushering of The Kingdom of God or are we a stumbling block for ourselves and others? Do we stand up for justice and truth? Do we enable others to walk in the His Way, do we help them seek Life? Do we really follow Jesus? How well do we know Him and trust Him? On our part we can do nothing, but through Him who strengthens us we can do all things.
