# NOVEMBER 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018 – THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"For the LORD, the God of Israel, says, 'The jar of flour shall not go empty, nor the jug of oil run dry, until the day when the LORD sends rain upon the earth." She left and did as Elijah had said. She was able to eat for a year, and he and her son as well; the jar of flour did not go empty, nor the jug of oil run dry, as the LORD had foretold through Elijah." 1Kings 17:10-16

The Ways of God are vastly different from the evil tendencies of man. Scripture tells us that the religion that God loves is to take care of widows and orphans, feed the hungry, clothe the naked, free the captives (physical and emotional freedom). As we see in the Gospel of Mark today, in the course of His teaching Jesus said to the crowds, "Beware of the scribes, who like to go around in long robes and accept greetings in the marketplaces, seats of honor in synagogues, and places of honor at banquets. They devour the houses of widows and, as a pretext recite lengthy prayers. They will receive a very severe condemnation." With purity of heart, love for neighbour and faith in God's Divine Providence, we will surely please God, and avoid lives of hypocrisy as Jesus pointed out in his scathing observation of the Scribes and Pharisees in the day. "Walk humbly with your God", and you will fulfill His Way to live life as a true follower of Christ. In those days everyone was required to pay the Temple Tax. Jesus observed the people paying their Temple Tax, including a widow who only gave a couple of coins. Jesus contrasted what she gave with the amounts of others who gave out of their abundance. It was not a burden to them to fulfill that requirement, but for the poor widow it was an extreme burden. She gave quietly, because Jesus had to point her out to the Apostles, as apparently they had not noticed. She humbly did her duty. The true Godly heart is the heart that gives without counting the cost, knowing that God will take care of what is lacking (See the First Reading). Mother Teresa is a classic example in many ways of the Godly heart, not counting the cost. She saw Jesus in everyone whom she was able to help. It didn't matter to her what religion or colour they were. It didn't matter to her if their flesh was rotting from their limbs, or that she had to pick worms from their sores. She quietly, without fuss, humbly went about her (God's) business.

When the focus is truly God's Will, hypocrisy will not raise its ugly head and wear its' various masks. The Pharisees were hypocrites. Their actions revealed who they really were. They prayed so that all could hear/see them, they wore clothing with long phylacteries streaming from their robes to be noticed, and put themselves first in all things. They stood upon their self-styled pedestals, and believed themselves to be better than their fellow man (remember the parable of the Pharisee and the Publican). Jesus said, "... do as they say, but do not do as they do".

When we give out of our lack, with cheerful hearts, Jesus is watching. When we reach out to those less fortunate than ourselves, Jesus is watching. When we put ourselves third, Jesus is watching.

Today is **Remembrance Day**. Let us offer prayer and thanksgiving for all of the men and women who selflessly defended freedom, who fought in the mud and mire of other lands until freedom was won. Jesus was watching and I believe He cried to see that, because of the arrogance and pride of sinful man, brave men and women were sent to war to defend the truth and freedom which He had died to give us all, once and for all. **Let us not forget**.
