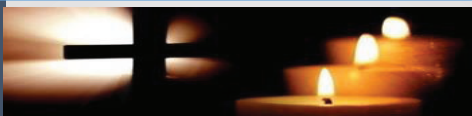

NOVEMBER 17th, 2018 – THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

All of today's readings collectively call us to be ready for the return of Jesus to the earth, the signs of His coming, and **how** we are to be ready and not be deceived by the world and its ways. *"But the wise shall shine brightly like the splendor of the firmament, and those who lead the many to justice shall be like the stars forever."*

All creation will rejoice at the coming of the Lord because he comes with truth and justice. Isn't that what we cry out for when we read of all the injustices in the world, and in our own locale on a daily basis. Jesus is the equalizer. The earth groans in her longing for the Creator to correct and justify her imbalances, pollution, and man-made disasters. Elsewhere in the scriptures, it is written that all creation groans while waiting for the sons and daughters of God to be revealed. That will happen when the Lord returns to defeat His enemies and restore the earth to His original design. The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice. Daniel prophecies that the Lord will return toward the end of the terrible days of tribulation which will be visited upon the earth. There will be those who will arise to everlasting happiness (*You will show me the path to life, fullness of joys in your presence, the delights at your right hand forever*), and those who will rise to shame and anguish forever.

How are we to show ourselves to be the sons and daughters of God? Our example to the world is in our integrity, obedience to the Will of God, and loving our neighbour as we love ourselves. Lives lived out of wisdom and knowledge of God's Will for our lives. Paul's letter to the Hebrews tells us very directly what has in fact been done in order that we all can be saved. Jesus, our High Priest, came and offered the ultimate sacrifice for our sin, thereby rendering no need for any other sacrifice to be offered ... *"But this one offered one sacrifice for sins, and took his seat forever at the right hand of God; now he waits until his enemies are made his footstool. For by one offering he has made perfect forever those who are being consecrated. Where there is forgiveness of these, there is no longer offering for sin"*. Fear not, as we look at the signs of the times for the victory is won! Forgiveness has been purchased for us by the Blood of the Lamb. Now we are to do likewise, forgive. Live as if each day were the last. Forgive, do not judge, look to yourself before you point at another's sin if you are to be counted among those who are being consecrated. Love one another, as Jesus has loved us.

In the Gospel today, Jesus tells us not be afraid of the times. The signs of wars, rumours of wars, insurrections, will be the news of the day, compared to labour pains as they come more frequently, and with greater intensity. We do not know the day nor the hour of the coming of the Son of Man, but we do know that He will come in Great Power and Glory. We are, however, told to know the signs of the times, because that will be our warning that the second coming of Jesus is near, even at the door. He has promised that when we stay true to Him, perseverance will pay off in eternal life with HIM, Jesus our Lord and Saviour. "Fear not, I have overcome the world!" Amen!
