NOVEMBER 25th, 2018 – OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

This is the last Sunday of the Church's liturgical year, and we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. In this celebration we proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord; He is the Risen One who is victorious over the powers of sin and death. He paid the price for our priceless souls. We conclude our liturgical year by professing that it is Jesus Christ who will have the final word in our individual lives and in human history. We also say something about ourselves. We proclaim that by calling ourselves Christians we are those who strive to allow Christ to lead us, to guide our lives. We invite Christ to be the leader of our lives.

But what kind of leader is Jesus? What kind of hero is he? What kind of power does he hold? The Scripture readings for this Sunday speak to us about Christ's leadership and power in a most compelling way. The First Reading from Daniel would be a reading that the Jews would be very familiar with, but not Pilate for he was a Roman. Who Jesus is was declared loudly and clearly in the prophetic reading from the Book of Daniel, in all His Might and Power. However, the One who stood before them in the synagogues and marketplaces did not appear with such power. Hence, they had great difficulty in accepting Jesus for who He is, the Messiah. They were expecting a warrior like King David, not such a humble man who said He is a King. "Your throne stands firm from of old; from everlasting you are, O LORD." When He comes again, will we recognize Him for Who He Is? Having a personal relationship with Him, knowing Him and His Way to Life, is essential for us if we are to recognize the Christ the King, King of Kings, the Alpha and Omega, when He returns for His own.

However, today we read in the Gospel of John that Jesus is a humble King. Pilate said to Jesus, "Are you the King of the Jews?" Jesus answered, "Do you say this on your own or have others told you about me?" Pilate answered, "I am not a Jew, am I? Your own nation and the chief priests handed you over to me. What have you done?" Jesus answered, "My kingdom does not belong to this world. If my kingdom did belong to this world, my attendants would be fighting to keep me from being handed over to the Jews. But as it is, my kingdom is not here." So Pilate said to him, "Then you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say I am a king. For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice." In this scene from John's Gospel, the identity of Jesus is questioned. But what is said in mockery is the truth. This is indeed the Christ, the King of the Jews. They had difficulty recognizing Him, because He came in Peace to show the way to the Father, and in His Second Coming He will come as a warrior to restore what the enemy has destroyed, and resurrect back to life all who have died.

Our celebration of the Feast of Christ the King is an invitation to look upon the Cross of Christ in order to discover our true leader and King. We must ask him to help us lead as He led, to be powerful in the way that He was powerful. Christ challenges us to lead through service to others as He evidenced through His own life. He summons us to be powerful by working humbly for reconciliation in our homes and families, our communities and Church, witnessing to His Truth. Christ invites us to exercise our power not by dominating or overpowering others, but by lifting them up, by giving life, by restoring dignity to those who may have lost their sense of dignity. Imitate King Jesus, brothers and sisters, in every walk of life. He is the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords.
