The Gospel of John 2. 1-12

The Wedding Feast of Cana

Can we listen again and for the first time truly hear the words of Mary? "They have no wine," Mary said to Him. She does not say, "There is no wine," but "They have no wine." The issue is not about the wine. The issue is about what the people were going through. They the people, it is about the people.

It always is. Again and again we hear, that Jesus had compassion on the people.

Jesus offers none of the usual responses we hear or often seek in such situations. There is no discussion about why the wine had run out. He does not blame or condemn. He does not suggest that this is the bridegroom's fault. He does not say that this happened so that the guests can learn a lesson or that, someday they will understand why. And he does not say, "Don't worry, I'll take care of everything." Instead he invites them to participate. God is always inviting us to participate in God's life and work. "Fill the jars with water," Jesus says. That is his response, "Fill the jars with water." The servants filled them to the brim and the chief steward tasted water that had become not just wine but good wine.

There are empty jars not only in our families, but all over the world, in our own town, in our parish, in our neighbor's life, and in our own life. These jars are waiting to be filled not with answers or questions but with water. Our work then is to carry water much more than it is to seek or offer answers. It is always in the doing and being ready to respond that the miracles take place. In many ways this carrying and offering water is the only faithful response to the other's needs and to our own. We are servants carrying water when we comfort a friend, fill in a gap and pick up the slack when others fall short. We all have water to offer which the Lord will turn into precious wine when we answer "Yes" to His command.

We offer water through our prayers, tears, compassion, forgiveness and mercy. We give water in our generosity and donations to various causes. We carry water through our prayers, our remembering the dead and caring for the living. Water is offered in every hour spent rebuilding broken dreams and lives. Every time we speak out for justice and the dignity of human life we offer water. Whenever we live in hope and refuse despair we also carry water. We give water in our love. We offer water when we trust in the resurrection more than death.

Whether it is a drop, a glassful, or a bucketful the water we offer makes a difference. It fills the jars. And you know what happens then? The same thing that happened at the wedding in Cana. The water we offer becomes the wine of God's presence – the blood of Christ and the cup of salvation.

CANNABIS RETAIL STORES IN BRAMPTON

In a recent letter dated January 17, 2019 from Cardinal Collins to Patrick Brown, Mayor of Brampton, with respect to whether or not Brampton will choose to opt in to having cannabis retail stores within their municipality, states in part:

"In an October 2018 statement recognizing the implementation of the Cannabis Act, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops stated:

"The Catholic Church for its part continues to underline the ethical problems involved with the recreational use and abuse of this drug: the negative risks that impact on psychological and physical health, the growing problems of a society more and more dependent on drugs and alcohol, the possibility of brain damage especially to those under the age of 25, the negative repercussions on families and local communities, and unfortunately the willingness of businesses and governments to exploit the drug for commercial interests and as a source of tax revenue, thereby even further jeopardizing the pursuit of the common good."

I would encourage you and all city councillors to deeply reflect on the impact of increased access to cannabis for people of all ages, but most especially, the vulnerable among us. The expanded availability of cannabis is a deep concern for many residents, faith communities and social service agencies serving those struggling with drug related issues.


