# FEBRUARY 10, 2019 - FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In today's readings we experience Isaiah, Paul and Peter coming to recognize that their past sins did not prevent them from becoming true disciples of God. There is a sense of shame from each of Isaiah, Paul and Peter when we read of their encounters with God, and their individual call. These feelings of shame are in their cases is an indication of abject sorrow for their failings, but also deep humility in recognizing their lowliness and need of God's Grace and Mercy. As they each said "Yes" reluctantly to God's call, the new that the foundation they stood on, that they trusted in completely, is in God and not in themselves. Their humility permitted themselves to be led by the Holy Spirit, who sanctifies with Divine Love.

While the saints saw in themselves many imperfections, this did not stop them from doing God's work. God left in several of the disciples many marks of their evil inclinations for some time after their conversion, all for their greater good. For example Peter who stumbled many times after his initial calling failed miserably in denying God.

How the wisdom of God differs from the wisdom of men! If today's businessman were choosing a director and assistants for the world-wide enterprise he was about to set up, is it likely that he would choose them from among the unknown, unschooled fishermen of Galilee? Yet Jesus, who was about to set up not only a world-wide ministry, but an everlasting one, chose these simple fishermen and made them His assistants and His successors in the work that he had taken in hand. It wasn't that He was restricted in his choices. There were many highly educated priests and scribes in Jerusalem whom He could have won over, men who could preach and instruct so much more eloquently than Peter or Andrew. There were even Roman officers who were highly educated, and who would be much more eagerly listened to in the Gentile world. Yet it was to none of these that Jesus entrusted the task of spreading the Good News of the Gospel, it was to none of these that he gave the keys of His kingdom.

Jesus was not influenced in his judgement by external, accidental qualifications. He judged the heart, and the will. He knew the true worth of men. Furthermore, the truths He was committing to the keeping of His ministry were not based on earthly wisdom which would require eloquence of speech and prestige to upkeep them up. They were the eternal, divine truths which needed no human promotion, no help from mere men. In the selection of his Apostles, Jesus has given us an extra proof, if one were needed, of His own Divine Wisdom and of the Divine origin of the Christian faith which we profess. Our religion is not man-made, God is its author.

As humble apostles, weak but willing helpers of Jesus, can we do without eloquence, or personal prestige, whatever He asks? We do so by living as true Christians in our homes, in our places of work, and in our recreations, by carrying our cross daily and patiently, ever ready to give a hand when a neighbour's cross seems too heavy for him. This will be Christian non-verbal eloquence, this will be a true apostleship of Jesus, because actions speak louder than words, and the Love of God is a verb. We do it!

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? Who will go for us?" "Here I am," I said; "send me!"
