FEBRUARY 24th, 2019 - Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus said to his disciples: "To you who hear I say, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you "

In all the readings today, we hear of God's infinite mercy and forgiveness, evidenced through the actions of David in the First Reading. Saul, David's now great enemy, was delivered into his hands. It would have been so easy to gloat over his enemy and exert his own justice over Saul. However, David had a heart that truly belonged to God, and imitated, God's heart of mercy and justice.

In all of the readings today, we come to know our God and His Great Goodness and Mercy. He reveals His heart to us, and shows us how we are to imitate His ways of holiness.

"The first man was from the earth, earthly; the second man, from heaven. As was the earthly one, so also are the earthly, and as is the heavenly one, so also are the heavenly. Just as we have borne the image of the earthly one, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly one."

Conversion of mind and heart are required. To rise from the level of the "earthly one" referenced above, we need conversion in order to live in the "image of the heavenly one." Love with the heart of Jesus, and think with the mind of Jesus. Although it was somewhat of a trend, we remember the WWJD idea. What would Jesus do? The readings today tell us exactly what Jesus would do, and what He wants us to do; Love one another, especially our enemies.

"But rather, love your enemies and do good to them, and lend expecting nothing back; then your reward will be great and you will be children of the Most High, for he himself is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked. Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful." For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you."

As weak man (including woman), we find it difficult to comprehend this. Turning the other cheek is not always on our radar. Jesus makes it so clear in today's Gospel. Even the wicked are good to one another. It is easy to be kind and to love those who are kind, and who love us in return. However, the directive of Jesus to love those who despitefully insult and use us, who do not treat us with love, and who devise wicked plans against us, is what leads us to move Heavenward, away from earthly thinking and earthly ways. We become more purified. Just as Jesus loved everyone who crossed His path, so we must too. Jesus knew their hearts, and He knew what they were really thinking, what their motives were. Yet, regardless, He loved them all. We too are asked to live lives of sacrificial love. As our enemies observe our love for them, in the ways in which we treat them, we are evangelizing them, and revealing Jesus and His Love to them.

As far as the east is from the west, so far He has removed our transgressions from us. That is ALL of us. What right do we have to judge another child of God, when His judgment upon us is so merciful, yet we do. "Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us" is a statement in prayer that we need to take seriously. We are asking God to treat us in the same manner as we treat those who sin against us. Therefore, if we do not forgive, we are asking God to treat us in the same manner. "For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you."

So let us pray for the Grace to get into the process of forgiveness. Letting it go, rather than seeking revenge, like David's example in the First Reading, and Jesus' example from the Cross, "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do".

Perhaps we can even be grateful to those who treat us badly and wish us harm, because they give us the opportunity to live our lives in the manner of God's love, forgiveness and justice. Amen


