## MARCH 17th, 2019 - SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT



#### Where do we belong?

Today's readings place us in a strange situation. It definitely asks a question from us. Where do we belong? Here or there. Looks like we belong here and we do not belong here. It is in this world and through this world that we are to find our God. Yet, this is not our permanent home; we are pilgrims on a journey to a more permanent dwelling place, a place of total union with our God of Truth and Love. That is the goal of living and we need to keep it constantly before our eyes. It is so easy to get obsessed with things on the way: our career, our financial security, the education of our children, the house we want in some desirable area... These are mere stepping (might be stopping) stones to a life beyond. We have to remember if we are attached to these we will have the same fate Lot's wife had. (Miss the salvation).

Today we read the story of the Transfiguration. Three of Jesus' most intimate disciples are brought to "the mountain".

While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white.

The apostles see the glory of God for a moment. It is a moment of truth "at MOUNTAIN". Suddenly he is accompanied by Moses and Elijah, two pillars of the Hebrew Testament, representing the Law and the Prophets (simply Old Testament). No wonder they were terrified or out of focus. Readings say "they were heavy with sleep". Maybe they wondered where do we belong? Peter wants to be there. Then they heard "This is my chosen Son; listen to him".

What is this Mountain Experience to us?

If we think sharply this happens each and every day during the Eucharist. At each Mass we attend, we are like the apostles on Transfiguration Mountain. Our feet stand on earth, but the Lord comes down from heaven in the Eucharist. At Mass, we are partly in heaven and partly on earth. We hear "This is my beloved son. Listen to him" directly or indirectly; but do we care? Do we transform our lives?

If we read this passage very carefully we can see this passage has some similarity with same apostles praying at Garden of Gethsemane. They were heavy with sleep. So do us. When we really ask the will of God for our lives he will point us to the correct direction but we have no energy to go that way. Secret is we have to trust God the father as Jesus trusts him at the Garden of Gethsemane. Then he will send the power to strengthen us little by little. It will be our transfiguration / transformation.
