MARCH 24th, 2019 – THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT



Let's have a drink

Today we will read about Jesus is meeting with Samaritan woman at the well (if catechumens are present). Anyway it is worth to ponder on this because it reminds us about our Baptism which we are called to renew in couple of weeks.

Jesus enters a casual conversation with Samaritan woman but she found a genuine reason to shut the communication. At the end she was benefitted by turn the tables and offer her "living water". What is this water that Jesus speaks about? It is God's Spirit which comes to us in Baptism. Baptism is not just a ritual producing magic effects. It is the outward, symbolic sign of a deep reality, the coming of God as a force penetrating every aspect of a person's life. That is what happen to her. She was transformed and started evangelizing.

It is worth to know how she was converted or got back to her faith. **First** Jesus invites the woman to come back to the well once more with her husband. Of cause she has five plus husbands. It is not the case here. Jesus' mission is to reach out to a family. We cannot ignore the family and go beyond. **Second** point is the water that Jesus promises is closely linked to conversion and forgiveness of sin. But the sin must first be exposed and acknowledged. Not to the whole world but to the person who sinned. This is what the preparation of the confession does. When we are alone with Jesus "having a drink" he will expose our faults to us (not in a way to condemn us, but as a constructive way). We should have this casual conversation with him very often. At this point we will not have any answers for him except weeping. That's where real conversion starts. Then we will step to the "confessional booth" to meet the Jesus face to face and receive absolution. The decision to step to the "confessional booth" is like "Sir Give me this water". When we are coming out God would say "This is my beloved son/daughter ".

Now the important part starts. As a result, in this story many in that Samaritan village came to believe in Jesus. And they said: "It is no longer because of what you [the woman] said that we believe, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is truly the Savior of the World." We might be baptized because of our parents but do we live it for ourselves now? Do we accept Jesus now? Have we ever brought anybody to faith? Forget that part. Have we acted the way somebody's faith has been increased? If we haven't that is our duty. By baptism we have bound for this duty.

It is better we should ask Jesus as many Samaritans requested "Please Stay with us, otherwise we cannot continue on his journey". And we should. Because he is our source and strength. Jesus physically stayed two days with them. Today he is prepared to stay with us all the time. He would not have stopped if they had not invited him to stay the night. We have to remember he stands at the door and knocks but he will not come in unless invited.

Let us pray today that all those preparing to be baptized at Easter and be renewed at Easter (this is whole church) may find that life-enriching faith for their lives and commit ourselves to proclaim the kingdom of God.
