Gospel John 12. 1-45

"When Jesus saw Mary weeping, and the Jews who came with her also weeping"

"he was greatly disturbed in spirit and deeply moved"

Have you ever been stumped by people who ask you "Where is God in all this suffering? Why does God allow bad things happen to innocent people?

In today's Gospel we have a simple and direct answer. Jesus is there disturbed, weeping with the suffering. Hurting along side of them who are hurting and weeping. He is always there. That is His promise to us. He is there even before we are . However, if people insist on a God that can magically eliminate human suffering then they will parish in their suffering; because they are ignorant of the suffering of The Son of God. The merciful Jesus, who for our salvation suffered unspeakable suffering. Every major religion of the world not only acknowledge the inevitable condition of human suffering they teach their followers to accept it. In our faith we believe there is No God without Jesus Christ. Jesus is the one the only ONE who is always in the midst of human tragedy.

Jesus is also greatly disturbed when people doubt him. "Could not he who opened the eyes of the blind man have kept this man from dying?' Yes, Jesus is also greatly disturbed by mankind's disbelieve but he stays in their midst too ...he does not turn from them instead he speaks His Word to them. "Take away the stone" Jesus is THE WORD. If we listen, even though we are lost in our grief or sinking in our doubts we will hear Him; if we hear Him and obey His commands we will see His Glory?

"Did I not tell you that if you believed, you will see the Glory of God?"

Why are we so hard hearted? Or is our faith so feeble, are we so impatient with the Lord that we abandon our post, we stop praying, we give up become hard hearted and turn away?

It is Jesus who stands in the gap and pleads with The Father on our behalf, not because He himself needs to ask, but because He loves us and knows our suffering and wants us to believe in the power of His Name. We have to have faith; that Jesus and The Father are ONE and that in The name of Jesus we have life and victory.

"Everyone who lives and believes in me will not die for ever, says the Lord." (John 11.26)

Next week we enter Holy Week a time when, if we truly want to be fully human, as Jesus is we will abandon everything and immerse ourselves into His Life.
