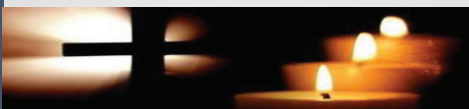

APRIL 14th, 2019 – PALM SUNDAY



Luke 19. 28-40

As we do every year, we began this celebration singing our hosannas, and carrying our palms. But no sooner the word hosanna leaves our lips we turn to tears. For some of us the mention of tears and weeping is enough to cause us to begin welling up with emotions and tears, for some of us, we begin stiffening up, fighting back the emotions and tears as if we've run out of tears even though the reasons for weeping remain. Well, today we focus on Luke's gospel and he says nothing about palms, in fact he does not mention palms or hosannas, he does speak of people throwing their cloaks on the road and of Jesus' weeping.

"As he came near and saw the city, he wept over it" (Luke 19: 41).

Perhaps Palm Sunday 2019 needs to include line 41 Jesus' weeping. If tears and weeping are Jesus' entry into Holy Week maybe tears and weeping should be our entry into Holy Week also. Last week (The raising of Lazarus) we learned how God shares in all our suffering through Jesus Christ, this week we learn how we can share in God's suffering through Jesus Christ.

Jesus' tears formed a river of love, compassion flowing between him and the city. We know that city to be Jerusalem but more importantly we know what and who that city represents. It represents the people of God.

It represents each and every one of us... the church. He cries today over our cities where God's people are meant to be a light for the nations. Instead, He sees prejudice, racism, genocide, the destructiveness of fear and hate based politics, sexual abuse of every form and human desecration, greed, ruthlessness, homelessness and poverty, the weak and marginalized being exploited. It is about us His people turning a blind eye. It's about our refusal to love, to speak up, to for-give and to bear up together in perseverance and faith. Jesus sees it all and he weeps. Later we see Peter's heart open when he denies Jesus three times, the cock crows and, Luke tells us, Peter "went out and wept bitterly." Peter is the first and the head member of Christ's church to cry tears of recognition of his weakness. Peter's tears are confessing that our life is not what it should be and that we are not who we want to be. Through tears God calls us home, and the way home always goes through Holy Week. Thank God for bitter weeping of repentance.

"Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me, but weep for yourselves and for you children" (Luke 23:28.) Jesus is Compassion. Compassion itself does not need compassion. He weeps for us and with us not for HIMSELF. He is saying here, yes weep for yourselves and future generations let your tears mingle with my perfect compassion. A tearful entry into Holy Week means we must first see and name the reality of our lives and world. Some of us weep tears that are wet and run down the cheeks. Some of us weep tears that are dry and never moisten the eyes. Wet or dry, they are both real. Sometimes our heart is pierced with sorrow, grief, and death. Sometimes it's guilt, regret, or disappointment that pierces our heart. Other times our heart is pierced by the pain of the world and the suffering of another human being. Some hearts are pierced with the loss of what could've been, dreams and wishes unfulfilled, or promises unkept. Other hearts are pierced by burdens and the weight of life. Fear, change, and the uncertainty of life pierce many hearts. Whatever it is and however it happens we've all had our hearts pierced. We've all wept, may this Holy Week transform our tears into the holy waters of baptism; waters of cleansing and release, waters of forgiveness and healing, waters of rebirth and new life in Jesus Christ our Lord for us and for many generations to come.
