
MAY 19, 2019 - FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Today's readings tells us that "It is through many persecutions that we must enter the Kingdom of God". The Apostles had deep faith because they knew personally the One True Living God – in Jesus. Their faith was so full, deep and strong that they were willing to endure all things for the sake of Him who saves. The question bears to be asked: why would men willingly suffer and die for that which is a lie? The answer, of course, is that they would not. We know the message brought to us by the Apostles is the truth, but it reveals to us the level of faith needed to endure the persecutions that must come to us as followers of Jesus. He said, "If they persecuted me they will surely persecute you". Have you ever been mocked and laughed at because of your faith? Count it all joy, brothers and sisters, as you stand in good company the company of those who endured to the end. However, there is Joy for us Gentiles. The Apostles opened the door for us, by the Word of God, to enter into Life in Jesus, to gain salvation through Jesus. What is it to bear a little mockery compared to the rewards of eternal life that we know is in Jesus Christ.

The reading from the Book of Revelation today reveals to us the Joy of what we Hope for in the victory of Jesus over sin, death and the grave, for those who trust in Him. Everlasting happiness is promised where every tear will be wiped away. There will be no more mourning, crying or pain because God has come to dwell with His people and the old things have passed away, behold He has made all things new. For this, the Apostles preached, suffered and died so that we may know this truth (salvation through Jesus Christ, alone), and so that truth will set us free as they were set free by the washing of the Word and the Blood of the Lamb.

In the Gospel today Jesus says, " I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this, everyone will know you are my disciples, if you have love for one another". To desire the salvation of souls, and to share the Word of Truth with unbelievers with love, is the missionary call that we all have on our lives. The salvation of souls is the desire of Jesus ... His Divine Mercy is crying out for them to be brought to His ocean of mercy and to be immersed in it. A contrite heart He will not deny (Psalm 51). As the Apostles and Disciples of Jesus preached Love and lived Love, are we called to do the same. Jesus has given us the commandment to love one another as He has loved us. How has He loved us? He has loved us by showing us not to judge, but to forgive, by being merciful and by teaching us the truth without compromise. He loved us from death to life in Him. When we live in this way: loving, not judging, forgiving and being merciful, we are loving as He loved, and are being obedient to His great commandment to Love as He loved us ... giving evidence of His life in us. Amen!
