MAY 26, 2019 - SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

The readings for this Sixth Sunday of Easter are about the necessity of the Holy Spirit, and our reliance upon the Holy Spirit's guidance in all of our important decision-making, from the beginning of the early Church. A line from the first reading states, "It has been decided by the Holy Spirit, and by us" highlights the necessity for discernment of the Holy Spirit to counsel and bring enlightenment as to the Will of God for the Church. The Church relies on the Holy Spirit for enlightenment as to God's Will regarding doctrine. It is evident that we must be prayerfully discerning people when we hear the words of others purporting to be speaking God's Truth. The Holy Spirit will guide us when we listen for His promptings in prayer. Unity of heart and purpose, rooted in God's Word, is a sign of the Holy Spirit at work. The Apostles and Elders were of one mind and heart, together with the Holy Spirit, when writing their letter to assuage the concerns of the Gentiles, because of what had been told to them by those who had gone forth from them to evangelize, but whom had not been commissioned and mandated so to do. They spoke from a Mosaic point of view, and not a Christ point of view, when it came to salvation. Jesus died once and for all. There is nothing more any of us can do to earn salvation. It is a Grace and Gift born out of Love. We simply have to believe that Jesus, (God Incarnate) died and rose again for each one of us, even though we were **still sinners. Incredible!** It is that simple.

God does not cast burdens on us. He calls on us to cast our burdens on Him. Circumcision of the body was no longer needed, though it is a tradition still today. However, spiritually, circumcision of the heart is something to consider. It would mean that we surrender our hearts to the Holy Spirit, to be cleansed and purified by the power of the Holy Spirit, the Refiner's Fire which burns away the dross in order to cleanse and purify the object of its refining, the heart. A point for contemplation.

In the Gospel today, Jesus said, "I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." He has provided for us an Advocate/Counselor/Supporter. The Holy Spirit came so that Jesus could return to take His Place at the Father's right side. When we are in need of good counsel, we pray to the Holy Spirit to guide us, to open our hearts to the will of God in our need. When we get that sense of Peace about the decision, having first earnestly sought the Holy Spirit in prayer (and maybe fasting), then we can step out in the answer, and watch the Lord at work. Peace is a sign of the presence of God. A well-discerned decision brings Peace, and if more than one person is praying, unity. The Apostles gave us this example of group discernment and unity in agreement with the Holy Spirit. The result lifted a burden from the Gentile believers, unity in spirit, and reassurance of the Love and Mercy of God in His Plan for Salvation for all. Halleluia!
