JUNE 30, 2019 – THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Total Commitment and freedom

Today's readings are focus on nature of the calling. First reading we read Elijah calls Elisha. We see a dramatic response in this call. Elisha also wanted to bid farewell to his parents. Elijah said "Go, Go". Elisha had a second thought. Made his hands totally free by giving a farewell to all his men and followed Elijah. We all know he received double portion of Elijah's spirit and was a great prophet.

Now let's turn to Gospel. In Gospel we see Jesus makes his way to Jerusalem which is the heart of his ministry. Most probably Jesus' plan was go to Jerusalem with disciples and form a new community to continue the work from Jerusalem and spread to every corner of the world. When he invites Samaritan village none accepts the invitation. On his way few accepts the invitation (we are given three dialogues) and had desire to join him (probably like us) but didn't had a proper understanding about the invitation advertisement and start giving the reasons for delay the acceptance of the job.

Jesus doesn't have fine prints in his job description or advertisement. No one can accuse Jesus of false advertising. Jesus tells us of the possible side effects of following Him: being rejected by your family and losing everything you have—including your life. He clearly says I have nothing to offer to you. No place, No money, nowhere to rest his head, but just the cross. Will you follow? One said yes but later. Jesus said Sorry Friend I need to fill the vacancy NOW. He didn't accept a very reasonable request like bury his father. Why?

Jesus always wants us to follow him with knowing one thing in mind. Cost of discipleship.

Obviously, Jesus is not telling us to hate the members of our family. He is not advising us to ignore the Fourth Commandment to honour our father and our mother. In the Hebrew manner of speaking, He is telling us to give Him priority over our families.

Jesus again says ""Whoever of you does not give up all their possessions cannot be my disciple" (Luke 14.33). This doesn't mean that we have to sell everything we have. Jesus is not telling the Church to sell St. Peter's Basilica and the Sistine Chapel. But He is inviting the us and Church to proclaim the Gospel even at the risk of losing our possessions.

Simply we cannot make our own arrangements first and then, only when we are ready, go and follow him. The demands of the Kingdom come first of all. Can we commit ourselves?

How many of us first plan our careers carefully and only then ask how we can be good Catholics, when it obviously should be the other way round? Aren't we part-time Catholics?

Why does Jesus tell us the possible side effects of following him? Does He want to scare us away? No. He doesn't want to scare us away. But he doesn't want us to be naïve. Jesus wants us to make an informed choice. He values our freedom. Jesus also wants us to know that we are not alone. He wants us to know that He has foreseen the dangers of following Him. In fact, Jesus is not asking us to suffer anything that He has not suffered.

In this part of the world, we do not experience real persecution. But Jesus asks us to be willing to leave everyone and everything for His sake. Jesus asks us to **give Him a blank cheque**. At the suitable moment, He will fill in the amount. Or, rather, the world will fill in the amount for HIM.

Are we ready?
