# SEPTEMBER 8, 2019 – TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### Gospel Luke 14. 25-33

So, who wants to be a disciple of Jesus? He certainly makes it very clear that this mission is not for the fain hearted. Today he seems to press very hard. First "Hate your father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and even life itself." Second, "Carry the cross and follow [him]." Lastly, "Give up all your possessions."

It is obvious, he wants to discourage those, who think that following Jesus is just about being feed, healed and seeing miracles wherever they go. It's that simple and it's that difficult. The time was coming when he would suffer and die a horrible death and they would be terrified and scattered. He was also preparing them for what was to follow: - the resurrection, and if they, as well as us want to be people of the resurrection, then we must endure what Jesus had to endure.

Jesus gives primacy to his relationship with God not his relationship with people or things. He is The Truth. Truth can and often it does hurt. Just like Mary and Joseph were hurt when, he told them that he was about His Father's business. Some were offended when he said he had no mother or sisters, but those who obey The Father are his mothers and brothers and sisters. The scribes and the Pharisees were frequently offended by Jesus' words. He is The Way and He had no place to lay his head. He carried his cross and gave up his life so we may have life.

Jesus is asking us to seriously consider what it takes to be his follower. The disciple integrates the teacher's life and teachings into his or her own life.

Learning to be and live like Jesus, is ultimately what unifies our life. So often we live fragmented and compartmentalized lives. We have a work life, school life, family and home life, internet life, recreational life, political and civic life, church life. This fragmentation allows us to place each of those different aspects of our life as the priority depending on where we are, who we are with, and what we are doing. That fragmentation is what makes us fall short of who we are in Christ. On the other hand if we live in Christ we trust ourselves to always be authentic, truthful and self-giving without partiality.

Today's gospel offers challenging words and raises difficult questions. They are, however, words and questions that offer true life.

Do we want to be fully alive? Do we want to be real and authentic? Do we want to follow Jesus? Do we dare to say "yes" can we drink from his cup? Can we lose our attachments to people and things? Can we set our priorities to put Jesus Christ above all others?

On our own power this is impossible, but through Him all things are possible for those who believe. If we say "Yes" what happens then?

Then we have life and have it abundantly in Him who is the all in all. When we love through Him, no one is left out and everyone has more than they can imagine. Christ has made this possible for all who choose Him. We too can be transformed into His image and likeness, through The Holy Spirit, the Eucharist, the forgiveness of sins and through the communion of saints.
