Gospel: Luke 2.22-40 - The Presentation of the Lord

The USCCB write in their Pastoral Letter on Stewardship*, "What is the reward to which good stewards can look forward? The answer is perfect fulfillment in God's Kingdom." So when the commitment to our life of stewardship becomes difficult and we're tempted to despair, let us remember the reward of Simeon that awaits the faithful steward. This remembrance should help us increase our labours of love for God and the Church for we know that we are not doing it for any other purpose than unity with God for all eternity.
