Gospel: Mark 1.14-20 – Jesus Calls the First Disciples

Fishing for Christ

“Come follow me and I will make you fishers of people.” Just as Jesus called his first disciples 2000 years ago, he continues to call us to follow him. As we reflect on this beautiful Gospel account, let us focus on one particular aspect, the fact that Jesus uses the image of being a “fisher.” It is most interesting to note that as he is calling actual fishermen, he uses their own language.

There is a deep spiritual insight that can be gleaned from this, namely, that Christ uses what we bring to the table to serve Him and the Church. While fishing may seem unrelated to being an apostle, Jesus does not downplay their past experience. He invites them to bring all of the gifts and talents that they’ve received from God, but instead of using it for their own gain, to use it to gain souls for Christ.

So too as stewards, we can sometimes think that God can only use us if we’re already perfect disciples or have degrees in theology or extensive training in ministry. However, the Lord wants us to bring all of our experiences, even our personal and professional backgrounds to serve Him.

If we have backgrounds in finance or accounting, we can use that to help assist various parish ministries. Likewise, if we have experience as a teacher, we can utilize those gifts through various catechist or RCIA groups. This is the heart of stewardship. To recognize that we all bring our own particular gifts that can be used to serve Christ. Let us reflect on our own gifts and graciously heed the call to become “fishers of people,” each in our own way.

HEALTH AND SAFETY UPDATES & OTHERS:

My Dear Parishioners,

With the announcement of the government of Ontario to enforce the stay-at-home order, the prevailing question is, "what does it mean to the parishes"? To paraphrase it, what are we supposed to do?

- It means when it comes to non-essential needs, the stay-at-home order must be enforced.
- Now in connection with all the essential needs of our parish, no restriction is changed.

Here are the aforementioned restrictions: Weddings funerals and other religious services, rites or ceremonies where physical distancing can be maintained and in compliance with rules on face coverings – 10 people indoors and 10 people outdoors are still allowed. Drive in services, rites or ceremonies permitted, are subject to certain conditions. Virtual services are still permitted. **(Only the Lector, Sacristan, and on Sunday a Choir of 2 will be allowed to serve virtual Masses from this time on until further noticed)**

- On the regulation made under the "Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act Stay-At-Home Order", it stipulates:
 - Every individual shall remain in their place of residence at all times unless leaving their place of residence is necessary for one or more of the following purposes:
 - It mentions about obtaining goods and services, assisting others, health safety and legal purpose etc..., but the one that concerns our parish is on work, wherein it says: **"Working or volunteering where the nature of work or volunteering requires the individual to leave their residence, including when the individual's employer has determined that the nature of the individual's work requires attendance at the workplace"**.
 - **Also included, gatherings for the purposes of weddings, funerals, or a religious service, rite or ceremony that is permitted under stage 1 order or making necessary arrangements for the purpose of such gathering.**
- Being of utmost importance, the spiritual well-being of parishioners and the financial health of the parish behooves us to open the church for prayer time, confessions, and drop-off donations as scheduled.
- Communion services will not be offered at this time based on the observation of last Christmas when not many people came even with the attendance of some non-parishioners. Just mention, there are some parishes that decided to close their churches after the stay-at-home order.
- To all volunteers, if you prefer to stay at home for your health and safety, please let the office know.

There are still many offertory envelope boxes to be picked up. **Please refrain from using last year's offertory envelopes, as those may have been re-assigned.** When you come to church to drop your donations or to pray on a weekday morning, please remember to notify the office on picking up your new offertory envelopes.

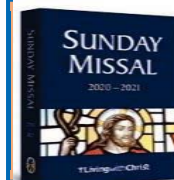
