# DECEMBER 5 – SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

### **Under Construction**

Last week we discussed about preparing ourselves for Jesus' secret birth in our hearts. Most of the time we think we are unworthy to hold him tight in our hearts every day. That is correct too. That is what John the Baptist told the Jews too. It is in today's gospel. Jesus invites us to "Come as we are" and he knows he has to use lot of laundry soap to clean us. Unfortunately, none of the stores have this laundry soap he Is using. He is revealing his method of cleaning in today's Gospel. Main character of today's gospel is John the Baptist. He is urging us to "prepare the way to Jesus". He appeared in the desert proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

Most of us do our annual confession at Christmas by selecting a priest who we don't know or an old priest who has almost lost his hearing. Don't we? But is it the way to repair a damaged relationship? Here are the steps that we should do.

Hear: Hear Jesus – Most of the time we just rush to the confessional after surf through the Ten Commandments as our check list. But there may be more things that we have done wrong which doesn't come to our mind if we don't ask him "Jesus How do you feel about my actions in last few weeks / months / years?". We can do this in a silent place in our own home or anywhere and reflect on our past (Blessed Sacrament will be the best place) to prepare our confession. If we ask him, he will point us where we went wrong. When we really accept our wrongdoings "Repent" starts at this moment. "Repent" does not mean just being sorry for the past. True repentance it is the start of the true change of heart, which we call as conversion, which is a radical transformation of our way of living. This conversion is the starting point for forgiveness.

Act: Taking actions to Change and show willingness to change - Remember now Jesus is born in our heart and we are new creations. He wants to lead and guide us. All we have to do is show our willingness. When we come to the point of committing same sin again, he will either divert us from the place or distract us. We should be sharp enough to understand his signals. If we really wish to change, we will love these moments.

**Feel the Love of Jesus**: In our day today life he will be present and will guide us. We will feel his peace, love and joy. No matter what happens around us internally we will be at peace. At this moment we will be willing to share our experience with others because this love is contagious.

**Don't misunderstand**. By following the above none of us will be saints. We will still be sinners. But on our way to holiness.

Our sins will not vanish, but we will see an improvement. That is, we say we are "under construction" towards holiness.

Simply prepare yourself to be a carrier of the gospel, not by preaching but by action. All these things cannot be done in a single day. They have to be constructed in very small pieces. We have to be "under construction" on a daily basis to accomplish any of this.


