DECEMBER 19 – FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Will I give permission?

Now there are only a few days for the "Birth of Jesus". It will happen. Today's Mass will prepare us internally for this great event. In the first reading we hear the promise that a small town in Bethlehem will give birth to the ruler in Israel. This was unexpected at that time, but a promise was a promise. It happened. The Gospel will explain how it happens.

Mary's "YES" started changing the course of human history. The first result was the visitation. It is they (Mother Mary and Jesus) who went to visit them (Elizabeth and John), not the other way around. Even before he is born, Jesus already comes to serve and not to be served. It is through service we will recognize him as Lord. Later on, he will tell his disciples, "You call me Master and Lord and you are right and yet I am the one who washes your feet. You go and do the same" (John 13:13-15). If we think very carefully, this looks like Jesus is training Mother Mary to do God's will. Yes, Mother Mary was prepared by God for this mission. After she said YES, the "Real Mission Started" and Jesus is training her towards the completion of the mission.

Jesus demands this YES in the second reading.

"Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you prepared for me;" (Heb 10:6)

In the very same way, our personal YES to Jesus this Christmas will change our lives. We have to say YES to Jesus first. Jesus Christ will not be born again without our consent. When we say YES from the bottom of our heart, our relationship with God (which was been weaken or destroyed) will be established again. Then we will have true peace and joy in our hearts, and it can be given to others as well.

We must experience Peace and Joy of Jesus (Peace is not the absence of War but inner peace, Joy is not the Joy we are experience from a Party but Inner Joy) and spiritual freedom by ourselves first. This can be done through prayer, confession and Eucharist. When you have this, you are ready for the visitation. Where should you go? I would guess to meet the poor (spiritually or materially) and lonely. Most of the time listening to a heart values a lot. Most of the time, end is Tears of Joy. Some people have everything but no one to talk to. Maybe in our own home. Our own elderly Dad, Mom, younger Son, and Daughter because we are busy.

Jesus can do all these things using me. Question is will I permit him to do these things using me?

Prayer: Father, purify the temple of my life this Advent. May I be a worthy and pleasing dwelling place for you.


