JANUARY 23 - THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Hope springs eternal, and the Word of God (the Truth from the Heart of God) imparts supernatural Joy to the hearts of mortal man, through life's events. "Your words Lord are spirit and life" (Psalm 19).

The first reading shows us how the people of God, even children, gather as one body to listen attentively to the Word of God, and Ezra, "opening the scroll" leads them to understanding, through interpretation and instruction. It was a time to come together to thank God for all He had done and to rejoice before Him, letting His Joy be their strength. That day was holy unto God. They listened to God's word attentively and bowed down in worship saying, "Amen, Amen". They came together as one body, unified to hear the Law of God being read to them and interpreted for them to give better understanding. Sound familiar?

When we come to Mass, it is hoped that we have that same attitude and give that same attention to the Word of God as it is read to us and explained in the homily by the presiding Priest. It is hoped that we live in the Joy of the Lord which is our strength.

Gathered into One Body in Christ—such is the true identity of the Beloved Community. This second reading calls us to explore this remarkable image, to claim our individual places in the community as essential and blessed. Each one is important to the perfect function of the Body Large or small, any colour, any shape, all have purpose and are necessary. All of the gifts given by the Holy Spirit are given for the building up of the Body and are given to everyone by the one Spirit. No exception. All have meritorious importance. Every part is significant and makes a difference in the Kingdom of God's day to day operation. Each part has its own dignity and integrity. We are the Body of Christ!

In the reading from Luke's Gospel, during the Sabbath gathering of the people, Jesus inaugurates his public ministry. Like Ezra, He opens the scroll, but in place of interpretation and instruction, he simply states the Scripture is now fulfilled, that the Word of God will be made clear and understandable through his life among us. He sets the captives free, brings Good News to the poor, gives sight to the blind, frees the oppressed and proclaims the year of the Lord's favour. The year of the Lord's favour is called the Jubilee when all debt is forgiven; slaves and prisoners are set free. The Kingdom of God is truly at hand. We are called to do the same things as the Body of Christ on earth. If we truly operated as the Body Christ needs here on earth, how quickly we would experience heaven, war would be abolished, disease wiped out, hunger and thirst nonexistent.

We are a sign of God's continuing presence among the people of the world. Let us get into the Word of God and truly live it out before the eyes of the world, that the Joy of the Lord as our strength will be a visible sign of the Body of Christ on earth waiting for Christ to return.

Amen.




