

JANUARY 30 - FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Like many of the prophets, Jeremiah was reluctant in many ways. He had no aspirations to be a prophet and found it to be a weighty call. However, God made it very clear that He had called Jeremiah to this vocation (He pre-destined him) and that He fully expected him to fulfill that call. He promised Jeremiah that He would be with him. God didn't say it would be easy — "do not be crushed on their account". Each of us is called to a particular role in serving God, the Church and one another. As reluctant as we too may be, our goal should be to fulfill God's Will and relinquish our own fear and inadequacy. God prepares and provides for those He has called. We can expect, like Jeremiah, opposition but we can be assured that God is with us always.

Paul tells us that without Love, we are nothing but a lot of noise: a clanging cymbal and a noisy gong. Empty and without substance. Love epitomizes Jesus. It is who He is. Love is the greatest of virtues. Without Love we are, and have, nothing, according to Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. With love we can bear all things, knowing that we are not given anything more than we can take, and always a way out of our difficulty. Love gives us the strength to endure hardship, and to bear all things – love is patient, love is kind, it is not rude, it is not boastful, it is not angry, jealous nor violent, love does not rejoice in wrong. Paul is telling us that all gifts are useless without love. This is a self-giving love, not expecting anything in return. It is unconditional. It is agape love. God's love. Love never ends. This love is required to live life God's way and to fulfill His call on our lives, selflessly and unconditionally all for the Glory of God.

Today's Gospel is about who Jesus is and who people believe Him to be. The story of Jesus' preaching and rejection at Nazareth is found in each of the Synoptic Gospels. Luke gives us the content of Jesus' teaching in detail, telling us that Jesus read from the book of the prophet Isaiah in the synagogue in Nazareth, His hometown. He proceeded to say that no prophet is accepted in his hometown. The townspeople take offense because "Jesus is only the son of a carpenter" after all. Familiarity breeds contempt. They resented Him and an attempt was made to kill Him even then, but it was not yet His time. He simply passed through the midst of them. What Jesus said, they clearly did not want to hear. They wanted miracles from Him, but their lack of faith and love prevented Jesus from doing so. As Jesus is confronted with anger, opposition and derision, He responds with love. This is how we are expected to respond in the presence of opposition. Not to respond in anger, but to respond in love as Jesus did. Love is our strength, and it identifies us in the world as belonging to Jesus. Let us never lose our first love, and always respond with selfless, unconditional love – even in the face of opposition. Always remember that Jesus is Lord, and never be afraid to proclaim it for the sake of LOVE.


