FEBRUARY 6 - FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, with the people crowding around him and listening to the word of God, he saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat. When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets." When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break. So, they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink. When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!" For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners. Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will catch men." So, they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him'.

We have heard this Gospel so many times we may think we know it well. However, this is The Living Word, and it produces new fruit each time we hear it. Jesus acts where there is a lack, and He fills that lack with abundance. Jesus still comes to us where we work as He did with Simon Peter. Like Peter, He may find us frustrated and downhearted at our lack of accomplishment; He may to offer business solutions at that time instead asks to step out of it and serve Him. Peter did not object to taking Jesus out on the boat to teach, he longed for His words as much as the crowd did; but after he did object to getting back to the job of fishing...

How do we come to hear and see the power of Jesus's words? Like Peter by being in Jesus' presence, by being attentive to His words and by trusting in His words.

We know for sure that we are all sinners and like Peter on our own we are known to fail. Fullness and perfection as the church teaches us, can be realized only when we totally surrender to Him and only in Him, with Him and through Him in the Unity of the Holy Spirit can glory and honor to God be given. On our own we can do nothing but everything is possible with God. Like Peter we will fall, we will doubt, we will experience exhaustion and fear and there are many times when we want to throw in the towel, but that is exactly when like Peter we say 'Master,....yet if You say so I will'...

This Sunday we also hear Paul stating, "I am the least of the Apostles, unfit to be called an Apostle" he had persecuted the church, Isaiah says, "How can I, a man of unclean lips living among people of unclean lips, proclaim the Lord". All three are quite aware of their fragile and sinful humanity. Peter is a fisherman without any education. He is stubborn. He is a bit of a braggart. At times he lacks courage. But God still calls him and gives him the ability to be the greatest and first of the apostles. All three are chosen by God. Each regrets that he is too human, and too sinful to fulfill God's choice. Jesus' words to Peter 'Do not be afraid" to Paul, He asked 'Why?" What is Jesus saying to you and me today?

"Come follow me, says The Lord, and I will make you fishers of people" Matt. 4.19.

Have we left our boats to follow Him? What are we still hanging on to? Why don't we let go of all and let God lead us now? Let us pray and give glory and thanks to God for giving us the grace to be open to receive all that He has in store for us.


