MARCH 6 - FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Gospel: Luke 4. 1-13

We are told that while Jesus was in the desert, he heard the devil quote Psalm 91:11-12, challenging Jesus to take God at God's word. The devil begins by saying, "If you are the Son of God...." The challenge is for Jesus to prove his identity to himself -- and to others -- and to take advantage of his power.

The Temptations of Jesus were real; he was properly tested but did not sin. Throughout his ministry Jesus faced very real temptations. At the end of this passage, we read 'When the devil had finished every test, he left him until an opportune time.'

We learn from this reading, how crafty and bold the devil is. He even dares to trip Jesus. He manipulates God's love for us to tempt us. How often do we fall for the lie, I was only trying to help...I didn't want to hurt their feelings..... I thought it was harmless.... there was no other choice.... it was an impossible situation..... We choose solutions that bring immediate relief only to realize later, our ways are not God's ways.

Jesus said "NO" to wrong actions. Just as He said "YES" to God's Will in Gethsemane.

It is possible for us to resist temptation, to make the right choices, to resist Satan and all his allure. We can turn from the pressures of our culture and society and be free to allow God's Will to be done in our lives. In HIM and through HIM is our hope!

UKRAINIAN HUMANITARIAN RELIEF

Hundreds of thousands of Ukrainian civilians have already fled their homes and are trying to find shelter in neighbouring countries. The United Nations estimates that there could eventually be up to five million Ukrainian refugees, depending on how the war transpires.

Pope Francis has called on the faithful to make Ash Wednesday (March 2, 2022) a day of prayer and fasting for peace in Ukraine. On that day – and the days that follow – a donation to help Ukrainians who are suffering due to this war would be a most appreciated gift.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will channel donations to support the Office for Refugees, Archdiocese of Toronto (ORAT) and the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA). CNEWA is a papal agency with a long history of humanitarian relief; it is currently working in Eastern Europe, providing Ukrainians with food, shelter, medicine, and transportation to safe locations. ORAT is Canada's largest private Sponsorship Agreement Holder, which helps bring hundreds of newcomers to our country each year; it will use donations to bring Ukrainian refugees to Canada as soon as possible.

Your donation will help Ukrainians who are beset by violence in Eastern Europe, and it will help some of them find a new home in Canada.


