MARCH 20 – THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

REFLECTION: Gospel: John 4:5-42

We, together with our brothers and sisters who are journeying through the RCIA process, are now in a period of scrutiny. "Indeed, the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern the reflections and thoughts of the heart," writes the author of the Letter to the Hebrews (4:12).

As the woman of Samaria very quickly discovered, the Word of God revealed the depths of her dysfunctional and disordered life. However, she was open to accepting the Word, and willing to make the changes needed. She was so amazed at what Jesus revealed to her, that she went back into her village and shared her conversion story, ultimately evangelizing an entire community.

Our story (testimony) can be so very powerful in the life of another. Even though the woman at the well was a Samaritan, someone with whom a Jew would never associate, Jesus spoke with her and even asked her for a drink from the well. She too was shocked at His forwardness, for she knew she was regarded as an outcast of the society of the day. Jesus knew she would be there at that time of day, as she would not go to draw water when the other women were there, much earlier in the day. Jesus met her right where she was, just as she was, right there and then. It was her appointed time to be offered living water by her Saviour, Jesus.

Moses was told in the desert, when the people thirsted for water, to strike the rock and water would flow – The Samaritan woman was standing in the presence of the very Rock of Salvation that would be struck down; from whom living, healing waters of life would flow to quench all thirst, heal all woundedness and cleanse from all unrighteousness on the Cross of Calvary.

We too can accept the living waters offered by Jesus, when we are willing to honestly look at our condition, and turn away from wrongdoing, wrong attitudes and behaviours and turn to the Rock of our Salvation from whom all living waters flow. We can come to Jesus at any time for forgiveness and Grace. He is always waiting to meet us right where we are, just like the woman at the well, to offer us the cup of salvation. So, this is the perfect time of scrutiny, of keeping an appointment with Jesus at whatever "well" in our life at which He is waiting for us, for our appointed time with Him.
