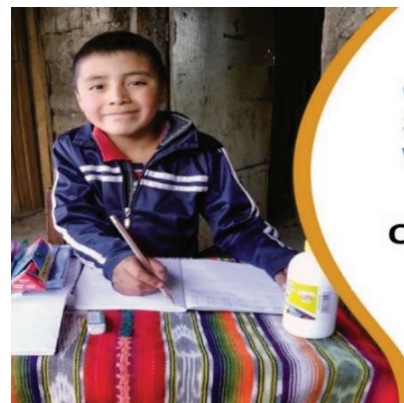
Gospel of John 20: 19-31– Jesus appears to the disciples
