## SHEPHERDS’ TRUST SPECIAL COLLECTION – NOV. 16/17

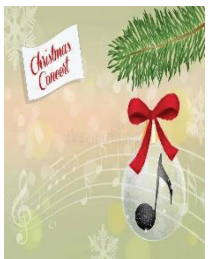

### FALL LEAF CLEAN UP

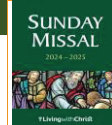
