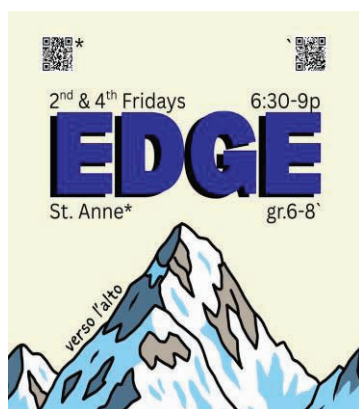
CWL Mary Matthews Public Speaking Contest

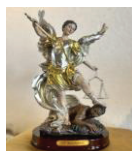
